Please take the time to read through and complete the following checklist to ensure you are prepared for the upcoming season. If you have any questions regarding the below check list, please email Mel Wright the Club Secretary at secretary@kincumberroosfc.com.au or phone 0423 88 88 55.

- ✓ If this is the first time registering with Kincumber Roos FC, please ensure you have provided a copy of your ID. This is to confirm date of birth to ensure correct age group allocation. This can be done in person at Registration Day or emailed to the Registrar Jennifer Murray at registrar@kincumberroosfc.com.au. Suitable ID can either be a birth certificate or passport for a child, or a Drivers Licence for an adult.
- ✓ If you have chosen to pay direct to the club, please ensure all outstanding monies are finalised immediately.
- ✓ Make sure you have applied for Family Discount if eligible (available for 2 or more family members registering). The same form is used for our Loyalty Rebate for 10 years and 20 year Service. This can be found in our Library section of our website.
- ✓ Record in your calendar all the key dates for Muster Days, Grading Days, Trial Games and Club Events
- ✓ Ensure you have purchased your socks, shorts, shin pads and boots. Socks and shorts are purchased through the club and will be available for purchase at Registration Day, Muster Day and Grading Days and any game day at Frost. Boots and Shin Pads can be purchased from your sporting store
- ✓ Follow our Facebook and Instagram pages to ensure you are kept up to date with information regarding the Football season.
- ✓ Join a Facebook or Whats App group with the other players or the parents in your child's team to make sure you can all easily communicate with each other.
- ✓ Download the My Game Guru App on your phone to ensure you have access to Game Draws once available.

We realise that for a lot of the children (and their parents) this is their first exposure and experience with team soccer. We aim to make the Muster Day a fun and welcoming experience where both your child and you feel comfortable.

This is a great opportunity to get to know the MiniRoos Rep (Nick Wright) and other key members of the committee, and to ask any questions about the season that you may have. All our committee members are volunteers and have the best interest of your child in front of mind.

The Muster Day is a day to familiarise your child with the club and to meet with other children who may be part of the same team, or to allocate your child to a team if they are currently not already part of one. We will be playing small sided games on the day, so make sure your child is wearing joggers (no boots please) and comfortable clothing.

During the day, we will also be calling for Coaches and Managers for each team. We acknowledge that it may be the first time an individual will be embarking on the role of Coach or Manager, so rest assured the club is here to support and guide individuals through their designated duties. Again, all roles are on a volunteer basis, and every Coach and Manager will require a current Working With Children Check and will have the support of our Coaching Co-ordinator Ben Macleod

U8-u18 Grading



At Kincumber Roos FC we encourage ALL our players from Under 8 upwards to partake in grading. This is a great opportunity to get an understanding of your child's potential strengths as well as which areas their coach can look to further develop.

In our grading sessions, our Men and Women Grade Players volunteer their time to undertake a skills based assessment with your child that will give an overview of their current skills in the following areas.

1. Defence and Strength on Ball
2. Dribbling and Passing
3. Attacking and Defending

We look to find the right balance of players who wish to further develop their skills in football with competitive play, but also recognise that there are some players and their families who play football for the social aspect and may question the necessity of grading. The reason we strongly encourage all children to participate in grading is that it will allow your child to be placed in a team with other players of a similar level. We believe this provides improved levels of satisfaction and enjoyment for your child and their team mates. We aim to make the grading sessions fun and engaging, and your support in bringing your child to these sessions is appreciated.

If you are interested in making a special request for your child to be in the same team as another player/s, please see the Age Manager on the day who can assess the situation and consider available options.

Juniors Grading Days are held at Kincumber High School on Wednesday and Saturday afternoons are subject to change depending on the number of teams in each age group. **The current time table schedule is available at the back of this pack**

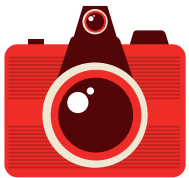

Player/Parent/Supporter Agreement



Upon registering with Kincumber Roos FC, you have agreed to abide by our **Code of Conduct**. The terms of this agreement are listed below:

- ✓ Abide and adhere to the club constitution, by-laws, policies, rules, regulations and code of conduct set out by Kincumber Roos F.C., and Central Coast Football - copies of which are available on our club website or through our Club Secretary.
- ✓ Seek approval from the Committee in writing for any activities related to Kincumber Roos F.C. e.g., use of Club Logo and club name, fundraising, apparel changes, fundraising activities etc.
- ✓ Abide by the decisions of the Grading Committee.
- ✓ Accept that all parents / guardians and or players are required to assist with Club duties (set up and pack up fields, canteen duty etc as required) during the season.
- ✓ Supervise my child / children at training and on match days.
- ✓ Consent to my / our details being circulated to team members, coaches, managers and within the Club, and to the use of photographic material on our clubs webpage, Face book page and in our newsletter. If you do not consent to you or your child's image being used for marketing purposes, please email the Club Secretary at secretary@kincumberroosfc.com.au as soon as possible
- ✓ Abide by any decision made by the Club's Internal Judiciary and /or Executive Committee.
- ✓ You agree to bring NO Alcohol to any junior game being played at any field and on selected Sundays at Frost Reserve where our liquor licence is in use.
- ✓ I/ we are also of the understanding that NO GLASS bottles or containers are to be taken onto any playing field on the Central Coast.
- ✓ I/we are also of the understanding that all CCF venues are NON-SMOKING.
- ✓ All refunds requests must be in writing and are at the discretion of the Executive committee - no refunds of club component if requested once season starts and a \$10.00 admin fee applies to all refunds requested and cut off date for ALL refunds is 30th May 2020. NB: In respect to the eligible \$100 Active Kids Rebate – no refund will apply and it is not transferable once it has been applied to an individual junior registration.
- ✓ For all family and loyalty discounts, an email or text message with the registration tax invoice attached must be sent to the Treasurer ASAP with your bank account details. The Treasurer will then refund the discount, once approved. The Treasurer's details can be found in the Committee section of www.kincumberroosfc.com.au
- ✓ I/we are aware that any complaints must be in writing to the Secretary and any Member Protection issue will be dealt with in a confidential manner by the MPIO.

Information on Canteen Duties & Field Duties



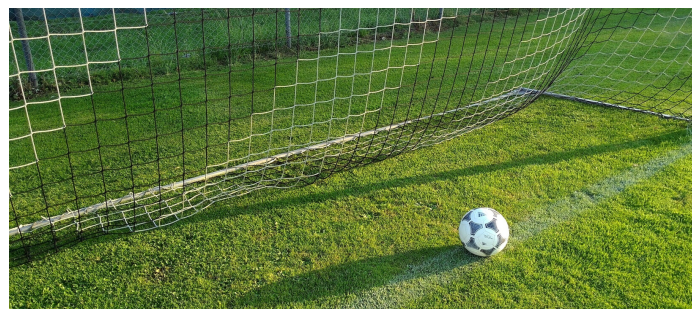
Canteen & BBQ Duty

Like most Football clubs on the Central Coast, our club is run by its members on a volunteer basis.

The Canteen and BBQ are a major source of revenue for the Club, and assist in providing an additional income stream to ensure Registration Fees are kept to a minimum. It also is a well appreciated service that is offered to players and their spectators.

However, to run this service, we require the support of our members. At the commencement of the season, a roster will be produced where teams will be required to volunteer in running the canteen.

If everyone chips in to help, we will continue to run a successful canteen. If there are no volunteers available for the allocated time slot, the Canteen will need to be CLOSED.



Field Set up and Pack Up

Our players can not play unless fields are set up at the first game, and packed down at the final game.

At the start of each week, our Fixture Co-ordinator will email the Team Managers that will be responsible for field set up and field pack down.

It is essential that players or family members support the manager in ensuring this is completed, or otherwise the game will be unable to proceed.

Match Fees



Majority of games played each weekend will attract additional Match Fees that are associated with the supply of a Referee and Linesman. If your child (age U12+) is interested in becoming a Carson Cadet Referee, please contact Nick Wright 0420 409 382

U5 - U9 Match Fees

Kincumber Roos supplies a Cadet Referee where possible. A Carson Cadet Ref is a junior player from Kincumber Roos who takes on the responsibility of refereeing these games.



Carson's Cadet Refs

This is a program driven by our Club and sponsored by Carson & Associates and offers our Junior players development opportunities and a path way into Refereeing. It also allows parents to enjoy watching their child play without the hassle of reffing the game. Whilst every effort is made to supply a Carson Cadet Ref, sometimes due to players draws and the volume of games being played at Frost, there may not be a referee available. In this circumstance a parent will need to referee the game. Please note: It is the responsibility of the HOME team to supply the ref. Therefore in an AWAY game, the opposing team is responsible for supplying the referee.

The fees associated for a Carson Cadet Ref is \$6 per game for U5 - U7 and \$8 for U8-U9 game. Your team manager will normally collect cadet fees at the beginning of the season after the draw has been released. **You can expect to be asked to contribute \$10 - \$15 to cover your child for the season.**

U10 and above Match Fees

Games for U10 and above are normally supplied with a CCF Referee to ref the game. Each time a game is supplied with a CCF Referee or CCF Linesman, Kincumber Roos will be invoiced for the costs on a monthly basis. The Treasure of the club will forward these invoices to the Manager of each team to collect the necessary fees to settle the invoice.

The majority of team managers elect to collect ref fees in advance for convenience reasons. The Club provide the following recommendation for **Team Managers to collect from each player**













U10-U11	\$15
U12	\$30
U13 - U14	\$35
U15 - U16	\$40
Seniors	\$70

This is a guide only. Depending on CCF's allocation of referee's and linesman will depend on how much your team will be invoiced each month. Your Team Manager will take on the responsibility of holding the team kitty and will re-imburse any extra funds (in case of no ref allocations), or request additional contributions if required to settle the invoice.
